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2018 – Farmers Market Nutrition Program

In cooperation with the PA Department of Agriculture, Lackawanna County is distributing the Farmers Market Nutrition Program vouchers from June 15 to July 20, 2018.

Vouchers are distributed on a first come, first serve basis. Distribution ends when the supply of available vouchers at each site is allocated.

A Proxy Form is required, along with ID, if you are eligible but need to have someone else pick up a voucher for you. Representatives may only serve as a proxy for four (4) individuals. To qualify, you must provide:

Proof of Age: Such as a driver's license or birth certificate; must be 60 by December 31, 2018. Medicare Card is **NOT** valid ID.

Proof of Lackawanna County Residency: Such as a utility bill or drivers license.

Income: Sources such as social security, pensions, interest income, annuities, etc. are counted. You will be asked to sign a self-declaration statement attesting that your gross income is at or below the federal income guidelines. At this time, the following federal income criteria apply: Single: \$22,459, Married Couple: \$30,451, 3 person household: \$38,443.
