AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ORDINANCE NO. 03 OF 2019 PROVIDING FOR THE LIMITED HOUSING AND RAISING OF DOMESTIC CHICKENS IN THE BOROUGH OF JERMYN, LACKAWANNA COUNTY, PENNSYLVANIA

WHEREAS, the Borough of Jermyn has an Ordinance providing for the housing and raising of Domestic Chickens within the Borough;

WHEREAS, the Borough of Jermyn would like to increase the number of permissible female (Chicken Hens) from four (4) to eight (8) on a noncommercial basis and maintain the standards and requirements that ensure that domesticated chickens do not adversely impact the neighborhood surrounding the property on which the chickens are kept and shall be permitted on single-family lots;

WHEREAS, the Borough of Jermyn council finds that amending this ordinance will further provide for the health, safety and welfare of the citizens of the Borough of Jermyn,

NOW, therefore, be it ordained the Council Members of the Borough of Jermyn adopt this ordinance as follows:

2.D. The maximum number of chickens is ~~four (4)~~ eight (8) per lot.

The remainder of the ordinance shall remain in full force and effect.
